PARKING

Parking Permits are required and must be renewed every semester

- University permits are required each semester to park on all university properties.
- Permits must be renewed every semester.
- LPR (license plate recognition) Technology is utilized on all UL properties
 - No decals or hangtags
 - Front plate required for backing into parking spaces
 - The license plate must be visible from the aisles

Commuter Student Parking Options

- Commuter permits – required each semester
 - no cost but must be obtained semesterly
 - Parking located at Cajun Field
 - Bus service to campus
- Girard Park Circle Parking Tower
 - Levels 1-2: Hourly Park and Pay: pay @ kiosks with credit card only
 - Levels 3-6: Permit Only: first come, first serve each semester when permits go on sale

Residential Student Parking

- Permits required each semester.
- Permits sold based on housing assignment
- Limit of one car per permit, one permit per student (except family housing)

Night Permits

- Available for designated parking areas only after 3 pm

Purchasing a Permit

- Fall 2020 permits are expected to go on sale July 14, 2020. *Any changes to this date will be posted on our website.

- In Person in our office
 - Bring student ID, vehicle registration and payment.
 - Accepted payment methods include debit/credit card, money order and Cajun Cash.
 - Checks and cash are not accepted.

Enforcement (a.k.a. Citations) *

- Daily Enforcement in effect
 - Monday - Friday 7am - 9pm.
 - Includes days when classes are **not** in session (holidays, breaks, intersession, etc.)
